1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and the class rules.

1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.

1.3 For protests where a Rule of Part 2 or rule 31 is alleged to have been broken, an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.

2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to boats of the Finn class.

3.2 Registration and entries will be accepted before racing on the 18th October 2014.

3.3 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the competitor's national authority.

4 FEES

4.1 Required fees are as follows:

Contest Entry Fee \$50.00 per sailor

5 SCHEDULE

5.1 Registration 0830 to 1000hrs on Saturday 18th October 2014.

5.2 Briefing is at 0930 hrs on Saturday 18th October 2014.

5.3 Dates of racing:

Saturday 18th October 2014 – (3) races are scheduled.

Sunday 19th October 2014 – (3) races are scheduled.

One extra race maybe sailed each day at the PRO's discretion.

5.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the each race day is 1030hrs.

5.5 On Sunday 19th October 2014 no warning signal will be made after 1500 hrs.

5.6 Prize giving will be held Sunday 19th October 2014 after racing is completed.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available upon registration.

7 VENUE

7.1 Is the Tauranga Yacht & Power Boat Club (inc). At the end of Sulphur Point Tauranga.

7.2 The races will be held within the confines of the Tauranga Harbour

8 THE COURSES

8.1 The courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward or triangle windward/leeward.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

9.1 rules 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

10 SCORING

10.1 The "Low points" scoring of appendix A will apply.

10.2 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.3 (a) When fewer than six (6) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When six (6) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11 SUPPORT BOATS

11.1 Support boats are permitted but their movements will be restricted.

11.2 Support boats must be registered with the Organising Authority at Registration (Clause 5.1above).

12 LAUNCHING

Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from in front of the TYPBC.

13 PRIZES

Trophies for 1st, 2nd 3rd will be presented.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

14.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk, see Rule 4, Decision to Race.

14.2 The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or Personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
