## SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SSI)

This sheet and Addendum A are supplements to Appendix S of the Racing Rules of Sailing (page 146 RRS 2021-2024).

### RULES

**SSI 1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

### NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

**SSI 2** The race office is located at NPCL club house, telephone 033287029, email sailing@navalpoint.co.nz

The official notice board is located at *the at the race office*.

### SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

**SSI 3** Signals ashore will be displayed on the flagstaff located at the top of stairs outside on the corner of the building.

**SSI 4** When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 45 minutes' in Race Signals AP.

**SSI 5** Flag D with one sound means 'Boats shall not leave the shore until this signal is made. The warning signal will not be made before the scheduled time or less than 45 minutes after flag D is displayed.'

### SCHEDULE OF RACES AND CLASS FLAGS (SI 5 & 6)

Day/Date	Fleet/Class	Number of Races	Time of first warning signal	Class Flag
1 <sup>st</sup> April	Finn Class	3 x B to B	1200	Finn Class Flag
2 <sup>nd</sup> April	Finn Class	3x B to B	1100	Finn Class Flag

**SSI 6** On each day of racing no warning signal will be made after 1630 hrs.

**SSI 7** One extra race per day may be sailed, provided that no class becomes more than one race ahead of schedule and the change is made according to SSI 2.

### COURSES

**SSI 8** The courses to be sailed, will be indicated by board on the back of the Committee boat.

**SSI 9** In the event that a gate mark is missing and has not been replaced with an object displaying flag M, the remaining mark shall be rounded to port.

**MARKS (SI 8)**

**SSI 10** The description of the marks is as follows:

Start : red Spherical

Marks 1, will be yellow, 1a red Spherical

Marks 2p, 2s, will be orange spherical

**THE START (SI 9)**

**SSI 11** When a starting sequence is in progress, boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area. The starting area is defined as the area 50 metres from the starting line and marks in all directions.

**SSI 12** A boat starting later than four minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A5.1 and 5.2.

**CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE (SI 10)**

**SSI 13** To change the next leg of the course, the race committee will move the original mark or the finishing line to a new position. This changes SSI 10.1

**TIME LIMITS (SI 12)**

Fleet/Class	Target time for first finisher	Finish Window	Race time limit
Finn Class	50 minutes	15 minutes	90 minutes

There is no prescribed time limit for the first boat to pass mark 1.

**CHECK OUT AND CHECK IN**

**SSI 13** Boats shall comply with the following check out and check in procedure: Check in at the club office on the lap top and sign off at the end of day.

**PENALTY SYSTEM**

**SSI 14** RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty

**RADIO CHANNEL**

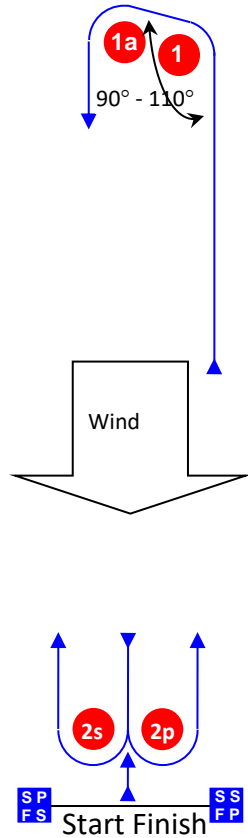
All Radio communication shall be on channel 77

**SUPPORT VESSELS**

**SSI 16** All official and support vessels when fitted with an engine safety cut out switch (kill cord) shall use it and attach to the driver while the engine is running, unless prior written exemption has been provided by the Organising Authority.

<b>1a</b>	Orange Buoy
<b>2s 2p</b>	Orange Buoy
<b>SS</b> Starting mark starboard end	Red Spherical
<b>SP</b> Starting mark port end	Race Committee Vessel
<b>FS</b> Finishing mark starboard end	Red Spherical
<b>FP</b> Finishing mark port end	Race Committee Vessel
